



NOTICE: **“IN HOUSE”** POSTING-THREE (3) RTG OPERATOR TRAINEES

November 21, 2022

1. As a prerequisite to apply for training, the candidates shall be P.I.T. and Toploader Certified and a rostered PAC Employee.
2. Candidates must pass testing requirements set forth in the Training Program including an acrophobia test (boom check), height test, emergency escape, eye exam and the “Hand Eye Foot Coordination Test”. Practical RTG Crane training will be a 2-week course. Any unexcused missed day will result in termination from training.
3. Candidates must meet all safe minimum standards and successfully meet all “Benchmarks” of the RTG Crane Simulator training program.
4. Candidates must meet all safe minimum standards and successfully complete all requirements of the Seagirt Marine Terminal RTG Crane training program.
5. Candidates must be able to physically perform the work duties common to an RTG Crane operator.
6. Candidates must have excellent hand/eye coordination, depth perception, be self-motivated, demonstrate great communication skills, and have patience and focus.
7. Candidates must have an understanding of container workflow, understand yard planning, and be safety oriented.
8. Candidates must pass a drug and alcohol screening.
9. Candidates must possess a valid TWIC, Port ID and current state issued driver’s license.
10. All trainees must sign a 1-year commitment letter to take work when offered RTG crane jobs.
11. Upon certification, individuals must meet a minimum of 100 hours per year in the RTG Crane. Individuals with less than 100 hours per year must complete a refresher course.
12. Failure in any portion of the training process, including failure to attend any portion of the training program which includes tardiness or absenteeism and/or any at-fault incident/accident or unsafe operation of the crane, will result in your termination from the program.
13. Candidates must have a good work history and P.I.T. record.
